Booking: Discounts are **automatically applied at time of booking only** when using UBC's full service travel agency, NorthSouth Travel or self-serve booking tool, Concur. Discounts are subject to availability and may vary by booking class and destination.

Pricing: All ticket pricing and availability is subject to change and is controlled by the airlines therefore it is possible pricing may be found at a cheaper price on a public site. Travelers who are not booked through the UBCTravelSmart program will not have access to UBC's emergency travel services and the university will not be able to track the travellers in an emergency situation.

Non-Employee: Discounts are not valid for personal travel and may not be communicated to non UBC employees, they may however be used when UBC is paying for the travel of a guest and/or non-employee.
